SCI / KTH

- Corona virus. KTH and SCI have not decided on any quarantine or other rules regarding staff coming back from China. Local rules are allowed but should be anchored with the Head of School. The central decision is based on governmental recommendation and risk assessment.
- New school management in place:

- **Retirement rules at KTH**. From 68 (69 after 2023) there will be **no salaried** re-employment. Establishing *Active emeritus* is the suggested approach. Contract establishes access to KTH, to keep email, to remain on the web, to be reimbursed for travels from external funds, etc.
- **Myndighetskapital**. SCI now decides to follow decision regarding myndighetskapital from 2011. No future generated Myndughetskapita will be allowed at bokslut to remain on *division level*. All will be moved to department level. PO proposed a local implementation: one account per division will be made at department level to keep streams separate. If there is significant build-up of MK, special projects will be launched. Myndighetskapital is not an issue for the Physics department so far.
- Strategic council at SCI: The Strategic counsil at SCI has members from all departments' except Fysik –PO have raised the issue and it will be resolved (not until 31/12 most probably). Council also lacks industry representation at the moment. PO encourages the management group to suggest candidates, preferably female due to lacks in gender balance.
- **Skolfest**: In order to arrange a School party one teacher and one student representative per department are needed to make a committee. Yulia M is already volunteered as the student representative.

- OTH centre formation (Bilaga 2)
 - Physics, Applied Physics, and other parts of KTH are forming a Quantum Technology centre (QTH) where the centre's potential is found very strong for future activities and funding.
 - QTH will start out as a "network centre" and needs initial local support. School pushed to Dept level.
 - PO propose that Physics gives conditional support to the centre establishment with 200 kSEK/year for three years. The proposal stands given the centre is inclusive and that there is a transparent, open and anchored process of nominating board and director.
 - It is yet unclear whether the centre will be administrated by the School or the Physics Department.
 - MW will distribute a more detailed plan to the Management Group.

• Faculty renewal

- PO gave a quick status report on the faculty renewal process. Documents need to be submitted to SCI to officially open the recruitment process. Conveners should fill out drafts based on templates Mark Pearce distributed. Presently waiting for more information.
- PO proposed to the Management group: Each group forms a small search committee and propose names of interesting candidates to invite to give a seminar here where gender balance in invitees is important. By next meeting (2/3) should be enough time for a few suggestions. Department arranges and pays for travel.
