- New proposed management structure
 - Similar to our current model, with some differences
 - Increased bandwidth to school functions
- Furthermore, we have identified potential need for re-organisation of the internal structure in the departments as well. Main argument is "a need for a management and economic model which promotes a more sustainable and predictable work environment, e.g., regarding cofunding of external grants or infrastructure costs"
- Division structure to be discussed and workshopped during spring 2023
 - "Too large" and "too small" do not promote the optimal working environment.
- Where to place what part of the economy an important discussion to enable the "sustainable and predictable environment" to be simulated first
